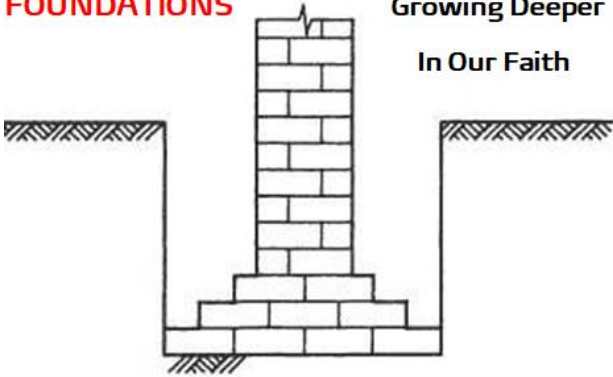

1. The Savior’s _____ and _____. (vs. 35-36)
 - a. The Savior’s presence does not promise a smooth passage, rather we are promised His _____ in the storms.
NOTE: We are not promised protection from the storms, but we are promised His presence during the storms.
 - b. Jesus never promised an easy trip, but He did promise a guaranteed _____.
2. The Saints’ Plight (vs.37)
 - a. There is typically a suddenness to the storms
3. The Saints’ _____. (vs. 38)
 - a. God brings storms into our lives at times, to bring us to our wits end, so that we can arrive at our desired haven.
