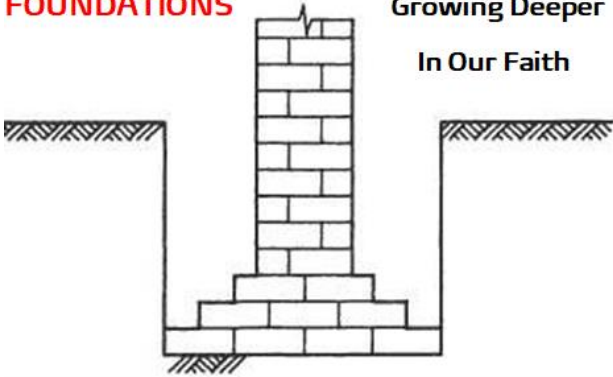

STUDY NOTES: "Truth in a Time of Crisis"

- How do we dispense the truth with purity? With integrity? Without compromising either the conviction or the compassion?
- I. In the transformation that comes about in our life and mine, it should be the reflection of the image of Christ – (a new creation)
 - II. To affirm in public proclamation is to also practice in private life
 - a. Living a double life...
 - i. Implicitly denies God's omniscience
 - ii. Explicitly challenges the righteousness of God
 - iii. Ignores the justice of God
 - III. We cannot use deceptive means (in spreading the message)
 - a. All of the moral laws in the world will not change your heart
 - b. All of the circumstances can never ultimately coerce you
 - c. All of the mystical experiences cannot satisfy you

- **THE LIFE – THE MEANS – THE MESSAGE**

Reflections Questions:

1. Why is having two different images, depending on locations, so vitally destructive?
2. Why is having a solid moral internal composition important in the Christian walk?
3. Who is ultimately responsible for changing your moral character? You or Christ?
4. Why is telling someone that Christ is the answer challenging if we are not living a life that proceeds our comments?
5. What one thing has the Holy Spirit told you during this message that might need to change?
