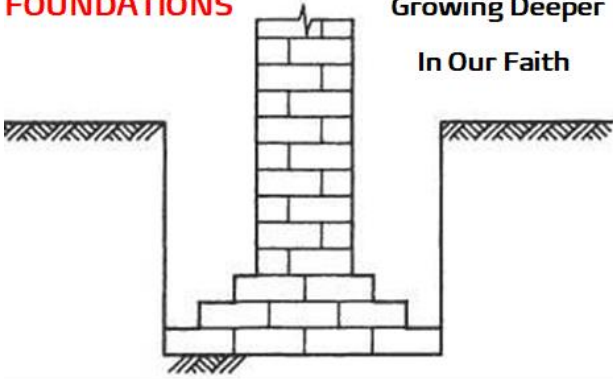

Reflections Questions:
