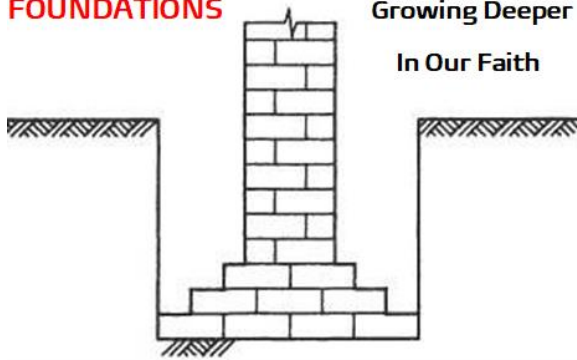

Sermon: "Why God Chooses You!"

STUDY NOTES:

NOTE: Everyone has been chosen for a purpose – Not only pastors and preachers

NOTE: God has chosen the weak, lowly, unwise, and unimpressive things of this world to do his work.

1. God chooses the nothing and nobodies of the world
 - a. God picks out the foolish and weak to bring Him glory
 - i. This should make us rejoice, not bring discouragement
2. God chooses the nobodies to shame the wise
 - a. To bring humility to the proud.
 - i. God uses Noah, a nobody, to humble those who mocked him
 1. God hates Pride – Proverbs 6:16-17
3. God chooses the nobodies so that all honor and glory will go to Him! – *1 Cor 1:29-31*
 - a. All of our boasting should be ONLY in knowing God.
 - i. Boast in Christ only

1. What has God "called you" to do in His kingdom? If you are unsure, then do you believe that God calls every Christian to do something?
2. Why do you believe that God delights in using nobodies?
3. Why do you believe that God hates pride?
4. Do you believe a "proud person" will trust and follow God? Why or Why Not?
5. Why does God want all honor, all glory? Do you think that God should share in this area? Why or Why Not?
